EVENT SAFETY MANAGEMENT POLICY

Live at the Park 28th & 29th 2019

EXHIBITOR STAND SAFETY

No pesticides and other substances hazardous to health should be kept on trade stands.

All temporary structures including marquees, buildings, information boards, fences and gates must be soundly constructed, erected and safe for their intended purpose and comply with the latest and relevant codes of practice. Participants must give regard to the stability of their stalls/exhibits and ensure that they are secured against any form of collapse.

VEHICLES

Those vehicles used for set up will have access to the event from 8:00am and should be parked in the designated parking area by 11:30am. No vehicle movement will be allowed in the trade area until 5:00pm unless authorised by the event organisers.

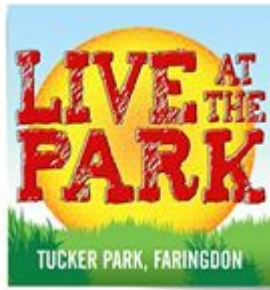
FIRE SAFETY & PRECAUTIONS

Participants bringing their own tentage, which should have been authorised by the event organiser, must ensure that it has been treated with a suitable fire retardant.

All trade stands must have appropriate fire extinguishers(s) sited in a prominent position and in full view, i.e. water, dry powder, etc., that is appropriate to the risk inside the stand.

FIRE/EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

1. In the event of fire evacuate the stand or area immediately.
2. Report the fire to an event steward by the quickest means available and the fire authority will be informed.
3. Move to the emergency muster area, highlighted in the site plan.
4. Keep all spectators well clear of the area.

ACCIDENTS/FIRST AID

The priorities are:-

- The safe treatment of the injured person
- Immediate actions to prevent a recurrence
- Report to the event organiser
- Investigation

INSURANCE

PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

Public Liability Insurance cover has been taken out by Live at the Park for the event to indemnify it against claims to the value of £3 million. However, it is still the responsibility of participants to ensure that they have their own individual liability and indemnity cover policies to cover against claims made by members of the public.

CAPITAL INSURANCE

It is the responsibility of all participants, contractors and sub-contractors to ensure that all their equipment and machinery has adequate third party, fire and theft insurance cover.

AGREEMENT TO ABIDE BY THIS DOCUMENT

All participants or exhibitors are expected to read and comply with the 'Conditions of Acceptance for Participants' and the 'Event Safety Management Policy.'

It is the stallholder's responsibility to read and agree to these terms.
